With EST 2.0, you can:

- Import and manage address books and shipment data.
- View and export 90 days worth of order history.
- Print paper or thermal labels for shipping.

Surcharge for unpaid shipping labels

- If you are a commercial customer with a contract, you must transmit your shipments and create a manifest (from the **End of Day** screen in EST 2.0).
- If you fail to create a manifest, a surcharge will be automatically charged to your account for all labels used. Youll receive a manifest listing the surcharges and you'll be notified the next time you sign in to EST 2.0.

Cancel a label automatically

- You can now cancel a previously transmitted manifest directly from EST 2.0 use the new button in the History screen.
- You will receive a service ticket number for the cancellation request by email.

New user validations required before transmission

We have improved the End of Day mailing screen to help you select the appropriate mailing for transmission. The
screen now shows information about each Statement of Mailing – including total charges, piece counts and weight
– before you transmit your statement.
